FESTIVAL POLICIES

Beer must be purchased and consumed on-site. Liquor control laws prohibit alcoholic beverages from being brought in from outside. Coolers will be inspected by security at the Admission Gate and all outside liquor will be disposed of. Those 21 and over must show ID and obtain a wristband in order to purchase liquor.

Personal tents are not allowed. The Society will provide a changing tent for dancers, however they are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

RULES

1. Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing (SOBHD) rules will govern all events.
2. All judges' decisions are final. In the event of a protest, a fee of \$10.00 must accompany the written complaint. This fee will be returned if the protest is upheld.
3. Dancers may only compete in one section.
4. Age as of June 18, 2010 applies. Proof of age must be furnished, if requested.
5. All Dancers must present a registration card to compete. If you do not have one, please contact your "FUSTA" representative.
6. Age groups are subject to change without notice in all pre-premier sections.
7. Pre-registration is required. Entry forms must be received no later than June 9, 2010. A \$15 late fee will be required for entries received between June 10-June 15, 2010. Field entries WILL NOT be accepted at the festival.
8. If there are three dancers or less in any event, medals will be awarded at the judge's discretion.
9. A trophy will be awarded to the highest point winner in each age group. Points will be awarded as follows:
1st-88 points, 2nd-56 points, 3rd-38 points, 4th-25 points
10. ISAS "*Most Promising Dancer*" trophy will be awarded to a pre-premier dancer by the judges.
11. Any competitor not ready to perform when their number is called will be disqualified by the steward for that event.
12. No medals will be worn during competition.
13. We reserve the right to add or remove events from the schedule and to make other changes as long as its action is within the scope of the SOBHD rules and, in the judgment of the Committee, is in the best interest of the competition.
14. Competitors will remain in uniform until all medals and trophies have been awarded.
15. No entry accepted unless accompanied by remittance.
16. Competitors will dance in the order by which their registration was received to the Illinois Saint Andrew Society (i.e. those who register first will dance last).
